In the event of a pending natural disaster that does not require evacuation, Village Life is responsible for providing guidelines to follow. Assessing the situation/natural disaster and if it is determined through evaluation that non-evacuation is the best protocol to implement, then the following guidelines must be followed.

<u>Post Evacuation</u>
After successful evacuation, Village Life leadership will reassess the continuation of operations and allow individuals to leave Tanzania without penalty due to any potential traumatic circumstances.

ndividuals joining Village Life to Tanzania are responsible for ensurnecessary emergency items in their packing lists.

For all forms of travel throughout Tanzania, Village Life leadership personnel will have a roster of all individuals within their respective groups taking accountability for each individual. In the event of a disaster, leadership will always have this roster on hand to take accountability and ensure all individuals are present. For every plan of travel, leadership will have a plan for cooperating with local officials on the nearest shelters and recommended evacuation routes keeping in mind vehicle travel



COVID- 19 Vaccine Exemption Policy

There are Medical and Religious Exemptions for the COVID-19 Vaccine that Village Life Outreach Project will allow. This exemption is only permitted for the COVID-19 Vaccine and will not apply to other mandatory vaccinations to travel. Deciding to partake in a Medical or Religious Exemption may result in additional COVID testing. All exemptions must be approved by Village Life Outreach Project Staff.



Medical Exemption

We recognize that some individuals are not able to get the COVID-19 Vaccination due to medical reasons. These exclusions include but are not limited to:
-Individuals who have had an immediate or severe reaction to the COVID-19 Vaccine or it's ingredients will be exempt.
-Chronic Conditions that the vaccine may interfere with
-Underlying Medical Conditions

For all medical exemptions, a medical provider must authorization of the reason for exemption. All medical reviewed and approved by Village Life Outreach Project Staff.


Religious Exemption


